Read-A-Thon

- Decided to postpone for now, maybe run in the spring?
- October is likely to have more power outages, maybe evacuations, and families have already been through a lot, not a good time to ask for donations

Halloween

- Distribution Day Goodie Bags - October 30, 8am-5pm
 - Teachers will be signing up for specific times to be outside in costumes, encouraging their students to come through then
 - We will assemble non-food goodie bags for every student
 - 356 students + 24 RVP + home study? = ~400
 - No candy during school hours because of district wellness plan
 - Bubbles, slime, slap bracelets, pencils, stamps, stickers
 - **Daniela** will look into supplies, order, parcel out to Boosters to assemble bags
- Post-Distribution Car Parade – October 30, 5-5:30pm
 - People can drive through parking lot with decorated cars
 - Boosters lined up on sidewalk (distanced)
 - Hand out goodies—flashlights? Glow sticks? Candy! Since after school hours
