## Boosters Town Hall Meeting

## Thursday, October 12, 2023

Called to order at 6 pm
Attended by Arianna, Lynnette, Leonna, Kati, Jaima, Kandice, Andrea, Angela, Zoom: Tasha, Harmony

## Admin

- Arianna motioned to approve previous meeting minutes, Jaima seconded, all in favor
- Arainna motioned to add Kati Leigh to Events and Angela Acosta-Angel to Ambassador, Kandice seconded, all in favor


## SPAC

- Arianna wanted to discuss teacher stipends to be equitable for teachers across the district, was vetoed by the rest of SPAC
- We do $\$ 150$ per teacher, other schools range $\$ 200-250$, not necessarily the same for all grades at other schools (more for upper grades because class sizes are larger?)
- Each school "sponsors" RVP teachers who are not on RVUSD campuses, but not necessarily the same amount
- Still no focus for the year


## Treasurer's Update

- We received an anonymous $\$ 1050$ donation from a Binkley parent to add $\$ 50$ to each teacher stipend, bringing us to $\$ 200$ each
- \$1600-2000 currently in budget (more in bank account, but teacher stipend checks are outstanding)
- $\$ 50$ secondary checks will be going out early next week

## Principal's Update

- At a PBIS (Positive Behavior Intervention and Support) conference in Sacramento with Mrs. Rastok, Mr. Gustavo, Ms. Lily, and Ms. Kim
- Learning good tricks and tools, for teacher incentives, bully prevention, etc.
- Sponsored by the district, because Binkley is furthest along in implementation of PBIS in the district and wanted to send one school
- PBIS at home session tomorrow, Andrea would like to see parents instructed on how to implement at home
- ELAC (English Language Advisory Council) meeting on the 18th, working with Diana to implement meeting as a breakfast to get more engagement
- Define what ELAC is, do a needs assessment, ask about future events and things they want to see, plug Boosters to get more involvement from ELAC families
- Needs assessment questions would be good to ask all families, but want to be careful not to oversaturate because Youth Truth survey is coming up soon, etc.
- Maybe send out just to committees to have answered
- Peer Mediator program with Mr. Gustavo, third through sixth graders, had to apply to be considered, meet with him once a week (last week was about using peace paths on campus to resolve conflicts), peers work with younger students ( $3^{\text {rd }}$ help TK-K, etc.)
- Want to have them teach strategies to the whole school in assemblies, make videos, etc.
- No official student council at Binkley, broke components of student council up and assigned to different grades
- 1st and 2nd - equipment crew, helping take care of recess equipment etc.
- 3rd and 4th - spirit squad, for spirit days
- 5th and 6th - beautification team
- Great Shake Out coming up (California earthquake drill)
- Practice command stations, grouping on field, checking safety kits, etc.
- Student Release part of the drill will be in April, will ask Boosters for volunteers to help practice
- Make sure emergency card information is up to date, can only release kids in an emergency to those people
- Waiting to hear back about whether parents can go in and update online themselves, rather than going into the school office to fix it
- No school November 1, teacher work day for report cards
- No school November 10, for Veterans Day
- Book fair week of November 6, will push hard this year because all funds go to the library and we only have $\sim \$ 150$ library funds left right now
- Turkey Trot - Friday the 17th, Harmony will wear a costume after break if the kids raise enough money
- Empire Soccer Club is letting us borrow their soccer goals all the time now, so we don't need to fundraise for them


## Turkey Trot

- Friday, November 17th, 8:45-11:30
- Prize for class parties (hot cocoa, popcorn, etc.), most laps in upper and lower grades
- Kick off on November 2 when kids come back after day off
- Goal should start at $\$ 6000$, then raise it and add goals with new prizes
- Need better solution than last year's stickers to count laps
- Index card around neck, hole punch for each lap?
