

Binkley Booster Meeting Notes 10/02/18

1. Call meeting to order at 6:15
2. We are going to be reviewing and approving minutes from Board Meetings going forward. We reviewed. Motion to Approve Minutes from August 30th and September 4th Meeting by Denise, seconded by Durae and approved.
3. Fourth Grade Fundraiser
 - a. Talked about Fourth Grade Fundraising. Mrs. Kjaer requests that we keep it 4th grade exclusive for clarity of fundraising and transparency.
 - b. Mrs. Kjaer will discuss with Fourth Grade Fundraising with the planners regarding future plans to coordinate with Boosters so that we can cross promote and help more.
 - c. Boosters is happy to be a pass through account for all funds raised for this Camp and will pass all money along to Binkley.
4. Treasurer's Report – we did very well at Welcome Back Party and made close to \$2400 in revenue at event. We have \$68 in the bank account at the moment. Mary's Dine and Donate only raised \$200 and only \$104 from Epicenter. RAT has brought in almost \$11000! Our taxes have been completed and will be filed shortly.
5. We are moving the November board meeting from the 8th to the 15th and Hilary will change the date on the district website.
6. Alison, Daniela and Denise are planning on leaving the Board next year and we should start thinking about recruiting new members/moving current members into new positions potentially.
7. Read A Thon Report – we have made nearly \$11000 but have not quite met our goal as of yet but there are still several days. Alison has made very detailed notes on the this RAT for the next one including some suggestions for next year. We liked all of the prizes because they were easy to divide out. We would like to get some idea of what the kids thought of the prizes. Next year we would like to get fewer gift cards of higher denomination from places like the toy store. We saved several prizes to be used at a future fundraiser. We also donated the books we received to the library.
8. Henry 1 Helicopter – only one child can go. Would we like this to be a fundraiser or a community event? We choose community event. We would like teachers and administrators to choose children that exemplify the theme of the month to pair with Disability Awareness. Then we will have a raffle off the ticket amongst those children. Denise will make a form for the teachers to use for this.
9. School News – Mrs. Kjaer is meeting with teachers to find out their goals. There will be a staff meeting on the 11th and there will be an upcoming safety meeting to be prepared for the Great Shake Out. Disability Awareness Day will be available on Tuesday, Mr. O'Leary's wife will be coming in to speak about Down Syndrome. Mrs. Kjaer's daughter is raising a guide dog and will be offering a lunch with the dog. Firefighters are coming the 15th to do fire prevention and awareness. Four teachers have signed up for the McDonald's Dine and Donate so far. Walk and Roll to school and Walking School Bus start tomorrow and will continue.
10. Disney Tickets – at the SPAC meetings someone brought up that they got 10 Disney tickets for their raffle by doing a Disney kindness challenge. You have to create a volunteer program in your community and track volunteers and hours and that is how you get tickets. Village did theirs in one day and called theirs "Kindness of Magic Day". Ally has experience with this at her

school. Does Camp Binkley count? Plan the date for this event backwards from the date of our raffle next year so that we can have them for that.

- b. Make packets of toiletries and blankets for the homeless and deliver them
- c. Should this be a benefit specifically for the school?
- d. Can we do something for the Mendocino fire victims? Especially since this is the one year anniversary of our loss
- e. Can we work with the Redwood Empire Food Bank

- i. Halloween Party Update – Event is 6-8:30 Are we going to charge for the Halloween party? We think that we should this year. How will we structure this? Charge for Haunted House and Carnival between \$3-5 and Trunk or Treat will be free. Use a stamp card for the carnival game wins and then turn in the stamp card for prizes. Carnival games will give people something to do rather than making a giant line waiting for the Haunted House. We can use the hole punches from the shed and we can include the Haunted House on the hole punch sheet.
 - i. To Sell – Halloween shirts, glow sticks and do we want to do spirit wear
 - ii. Haunted House – this year we will have a time for the little kids to go through
 - iii. Carnival Games – games planned; tic tac toe, plinko, bean bag toss, go fish, race boats and donate a \$1 to put your parent in jail. Amy will make a giant tic tac toe board
 - iv. Costume Contest or Baking Contest? We love these ideas but we are feeling like we may not have enough volunteers/Boosters to take care of all of these added aspects to the event. With a costume contest we are concerned that kids are going to want to be a part of the contest but will be in line to do games or the haunted house etc. We have decided against these ideas for this event this year.
 - v. Volunteers – Need a wolfman for the haunted house. Carnival games need to be manned, can we get high school kids who need community service hours? Gigi will reach out to Montgomery and Maria Carillo to find out if any of the kids want to help.
 - vi. Prop Building – Gigi has a list of what is being made on a week to week basis. Volunteers can come help with any of these projects
 - vii. Candy Collection – can we put out a basket in the office for the candy donations. Can student council help with this in the morning to collect it?
- j. See's Candy – We will have a supplemental assembly for the launch of See's. Daniela will find out the delivery date of the candy and email Hilary so we can figure out where we will unpack this as the portables are all taken. We will ask Stephanie to launch the assembly with us, maybe she can bring in lollipops for everyone.
- k. Holiday Craft Fair – we are rebranding this as a Holiday Party to get more community involvement. We will brain storm on this and come up with more ideas.

- l. Parent Paint Night – Third Street Aleworks has agreed to be the location. Danielle’s cost of supplies are \$15. She can accommodate up to 50 people. We need to decide what ticket prices should be and if they should include an appetizer and drink. We should all think about that and decide. January 25th is the date scheduled for this and the time will be 7-9.
