# **Boosters Town Hall Meeting**

Tuesday, November 14, 2023

Called to order at 6pm

#### Admin

- Arianna motioned to approve previous meeting minutes, Harmony seconded, all in favor
- Arianna motioned to add Nathan White as Ambassador, Kandice seconded, all in favor
- Kandice motioned to add Josh Rose as Ambassador, Arianna seconded, all in favor

# **Turkey Trot**

- Friday, November 17<sup>th</sup>
  - o TK-3rd 9-9:30am
  - o 4th-6th 10:45-11:15am
  - o Times may be adjusted if rain
    - If time changes, Tahryn can send out a message to let parent volunteers know
  - o Staggered start places on track again to avoid bottlenecks
- Reached all three goals: TK puppet theater, basketball hoop, popcorn machine and popcorn party for the whole school
  - Lizzy will research popcorn machines, Harmony has already chosen puppet theater and basketball hoop
  - Leonna will look into puppets to go with the theater
- Harmony has told students for each \$100 over \$6000 they will get a can of silly string to shoot at her
  - Will announce prizes at assembly after break, then silly string
- Teachers should collect lanyards with plastic sleeves after turkey trot, write number of class laps on bag, return bag to the office Booster box
- Prizes:
  - Upper grade classes, class with the most laps and most money raised
  - o Lower grade classes, class with the most laps and most money raised
  - o All students with donations (currently 68) get a Fundemonium gift certificate/coupon
  - Kandice will pick up cash on Friday after school, input into 99pledges over break and email parents
    of students who have pledges based on laps (so they can input laps over break before it closes)

# Reading & Math Intervention – Katie Hill

- Katie Hill and Kristi Meyers run The Learning Lab, RSP teacher and student support coordinator
  - Students can come to work in small groups, take assessments, work in a quiet space, get interventions, encouragement
  - o Schedule so groups can be seen by grade level, support reading groups, math groups
  - Students can join through an IEP, be recommended by a teacher
  - These two work together which not common at other campuses, collaborate to support students, target students' goals
  - Work together with paraeducators, help organize USE (Unique Support and Extension) time and support students' reading groups
    - During USE time, classroom teachers don't teach anything new so students don't miss out

- One can be teaching something to the group while the other goes around to check for understanding with each student
- See about 90 students a day in the Learning Lab, also push into classrooms to help as necessary (TK & K students don't come to the learning lab, they go into classrooms)
- Extra funding after Covid allowed us to add a couple of paraprofessionals (Ms Pak and Ms Ashley),
   Title I funding last year got us Ms Brianna
  - Unknown how long this funding will last and how much we will have going forward
- o Paraprofessionals are also trained to work with students who are at or above grade level
  - E.g. Great Books, math games
- Current math curriculum is Eureka math, which loops back through review and new material, kids liked Dream Box last year and Prodigy (fun but not very deep), but district is adopting new math program by the end of this year
- Kids who are below grade level are getting support and intervention, what do we do for students who
  are at or above grade level? There is no more GATE program, is just part of classroom teacher's
  responsibility
- Parents want more information about what their students are doing during class, who are they
  working with, what enrichment are they getting
  - Next trimester let's add to parent communication what the class's USE time is spent on, what enrichment and support are they getting

## PΕ

- School has a PE lesson plan (called Sparks), is administered by classroom teachers
- Could add a "PE docent" like we have an art docent program
  - Have to be careful to make it equitable between classes, can't have for just one class or grade
  - o Art docent is available to all teachers, can choose to opt out if they want but is offered to all
- PE teacher position went away just before Covid for the whole district
- Andrea will look into getting volunteers

## Treasurer's Update

- \$2341.45 in bank currently
- Recent fundraising:
  - \$1517 spirit wear
  - \$2614.71 pasta feed
  - o \$176.36 movie night
  - o \$277 dine and donates
  - Turkey Trot TBD (\$7,245 as of this meeting)

## Principal's Update

- November 15 is Ruby Bridges Walk to School day
  - Students have been learning about who she was
- TK & K tour starting for next year's enrollment
- One TK and K classroom will switch places next year in order to be state compliant (TK rooms must have bathrooms)
- Don't know how many classes we'll have next year (combo 4th/5th class may become combo 5th/6th next year, won't know until superintendent makes decision around April)
- PBIS (Positive Behavioral Intervention and Support) includes lots of tickets for students, lower grades have filled up ticket jar and get a bubble party this week

- Folklorico dance classes have been practicing after school on Wednesdays, will be performing Friday afternoon before school gets out, next 8ish week session will be salsa
- No school next week
- No student council but different classes/grades handle different elements, 5th and 6th grades can apply to be on Principal Advisory Student Council (interviewed today: what do you like best about your school, what do you like least about your school, what do you want to change)
- Winter Break Binkley will host extended care enrichment class, extended care will buy new equipment in exchange (different color so we can tell TK/K equipment from everyone else's so they get them back when it rolls onto the big kid playground)
- School Site Council need one more volunteer, meets four times a year, required by law, review school safety plan

#### **RVP Communications**

- Problem with communication is that RVP is a separate school, so we don't necessarily have contact information like we do for everyone else in parent directory
- RVP teachers don't necessarily use ParentSquare so their students' parents may not be signed up/familiar
- Andrea and Harmony will talk to RVP classes and teachers to make sure that they know they are included
  in everything, we want them at events, we want them to help with fundraising, we want them on field trips,
  they are part of the Binkley community
  - Arianna could visit like she did for ELAC
  - Want RVP families to feel like they can come to Boosters and have input on events, what could we
    do to be more inclusive, etc.
