Admin

- Arianna motioned to approve previous meeting minutes, Lynnette seconded, all in favor
- Sound System
 - Currently have two sound systems
 - One is very old, doesn't connect to Bluetooth, hard to use, whole large AV cart
 - One is a couple years old, portable Bose speaker, connects to Bluetooth, but isn't loud enough for whole-school outdoor events (like Turkey Trot)
 - Jacob Lopez will take a look at the Bose we already have, see if we can add a second speaker, see if Bluetooth microphones from the gym can connect

Treasurer's Update - Tasha

- Bank balance is \$3,993.67
- Outgoing money:
 - Yearbook check for \$2000 has not been cashed
 - Owe Binkley \$2000
- Incoming money:
 - See's cash and checks will be deposited tomorrow, about \$950
 - See's online profits will be a month or two, about \$630
 - Turkey Trot earned \$8,759.51
 - Still missing dine and donate checks from Shake Shack and BJs
- Tasha will get a cashier's check (\$50) for the ABC license for Paint Wine Night

- \$25 per ticket, have to buy ahead of time, extra in person for food, wine, beer

- Will use projector in the MPR so people can see, Andrea will ask Tara how she's done it in the past
- Lynnette & Andrea will get a facilities request form from Tahryn
- Boosters will provide a ticket for Tahryn to attend (day before her birthday!)

Playground Projects – Priscilla

- We are hoping to be able to allocate \$500 more to playground improvement in January
 - Highest priority items are ~\$170 storage bench, \$200 astroturf and storage, ~\$100 covers for tables so they can use for art
 - Existing metal tables are used for snack, wooden spool tables are for art but they are not smooth
- Will move 2 benches that were decorated last year into the playground space, keep one plain one in the gym because kids are using it at breakfast
- Garden shed to be painted as 6th grade project in the spring
